Conservation and Land Management Act 1984

ORDER IN COUNCIL

CALM 024548F3005; DLA 2313/50.

WHEREAS by the Conservation and Land Management Act 1984 it is provided that Crown land dedicated as a State forest may be revoked in whole or in part in the following manner—

- (a) the Governor shall cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament a proposal for such revocation;
- (b) after such proposal has been laid before Parliament the Governor, on a resolution being passed by both Houses that such proposal be carried out, shall by Order in Council published in the *Gazette* revoke such dedication;

and whereas his Excellency the Governor did cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament, his proposal dated the 12th day of May, 1987, for the partial revocation of State forest Nos. 4, 14, 22, 27, 38, 40, 41 and 55: and whereas after such proposal had been laid before Parliament a resolution was passed by both Houses that such proposal should be carried out: now, therefore, His Excellency the

Governor with the advice and consent of the Executive Council doth hereby revoke in part the dedication of Crown land as State forest No. 22 described in the Schedule hereto.

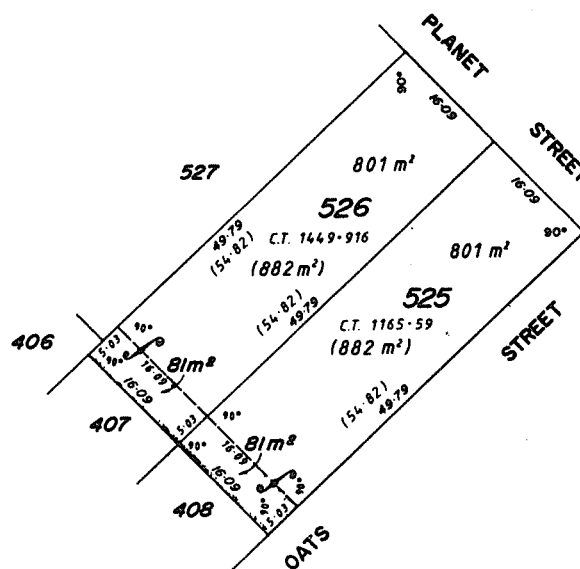
