#### PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency John Stephen Hampton, Esquire, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same.

HEREAS it is enacted by the second section of the "Small Debts Ordinance, 1863," that it shall be lawful for the Governor from time to time, and at any time by Proclamation published in the Western Australian Government Gazette, to constitute Local Courts for the recovery of Small Debts and Demands, to be holden at such times and places, and within such Districts throughout the said Colony as may be most fit and convenient, and as may be specified in such Proclamation, and likewise by Proclamation to alter the time or place or manner of holding any such Courts, and that it has been deemed expedient to alter as hereinafter specified the time for holding the Local Court in Newcastle; Now therefore I, the said Governor, in exercise of such power, do hereby notify and proclaim that from and after this date the Local Court in the district of Toodyay shall be holden at the Police Court, in the Town of Newcastle, on the second Tuesday in each month.
