PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency John Stephen Hampton, Esquire, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same.

HEREAS by an Ordinance of the Legislative Council of the said Colony, made and passed in the Twenty Seventh Year of the Reign of Her Most Gracious Majesty Queen Victoria, No. 1, entitled "An Ordinance for the recovery of Small Debts and Demands," the Governor is empowered by Proclamation to constitute Local Courts for the recovery of Small Debts and Demands to be holden at such times and places, and within such Districts throughout the said Colony as may be most fit and convenient,

Now THEREFORE I, the said Governor do hereby notify and proclaim, and do hereby constitute a Local Court for the recovery of Small Debts and Demands, to be holden on the First Wednesday in each month at the hour of Eleven o'clock in the forenoon, at Greenough, in the Victoria District.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the Colony, at Government House, Perth, this Twenty Ninth day of July, 1867.
