HEREAS under and by virtue of the provisions of "The Destructive Insects and Substances Act, 1880," the Governor in Executive Council may from time to time make such orders as he may think expedient for preventing the introduction into Western Australia of insects or of matter destructive or prejudicial to vegetation; AND WHEREAS certain insects highly destructive and prejudicial to vegetation are or may be imported into the said Colony enclosed or embedded in Apples or Pears; Now THEREFORE I, the said Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation make the Order following, that is to say :-

"After the 15th day of April next, no Apples "or Pears except in a preserved or dried state "shall be imported into Champion Bay, or into "any port to the South thereof."

And all persons whom it may concern are hereby enjoined to take notice of this Order and govern themselves accordingly, and are hereby warned that any person who shall import or attempt to import fruit in contravention of this Order is liable to forfeitures and penalties under the said Act.

Given at Government House, Perth, this seventh day of March, 1889, under my hand and the Public Seal of the said Colony.


