IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the fifth section of "The Bank Holidays Act, 1884," I, Sir Frederick Napier Broome, Governor of the said Colony, do by this my Proclamation appoint

Thursday and Friday, the 30th and 31st of May, instant,

special days to be observed as Bank Holidays at the Towns of Roebourne and Cossack, in the said Colony.
