KNOW ye that we, being well satisfied of your loyalty, integrity, and ability, have nominated, constituted, and appointed, and by these presents do nominate, constitute, and appoint you to be the third of Our Puisne Judges for this Our State of Western Australia, to have, hold, exercise, and enjoy the said Office and place during good behaviour, together with all the rights, profits, privileges, and advantages thereunto belonging or appertaining. Provided always, and these presents are and shall be upon this condition, that you shall actually reside within Our said State of Western Australia, and shall execute the said Office in your own person, except in case of sickness or other incapacity.

In faith and testimony whereof We have caused Our trusty and well-beloved Colonel Sir William Robert Campion, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, D.S.O., Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, in the Commonwealth of Australia, to affix to these presents the seal of the State of Western Australia, at Perth, in the said State, this First day of March, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty.
