In the matter of an Application to amend Industrial Agreement No. 5 of 1925, dated the 20th day of January, 1925, declared a Common Rule between Drew, Robinson & Co., and others, Applicants, and the West Australian Shop Assistants & Warehouse Employees' Industrial Union of Workers, Perth, Respondents.

The 12th day of March, 1931.

UPON hearing Mr. L. L. Carter, on behalf of the applicants, and Mr. R. Bourke, on behalf of the respondents, the Court doth hereby order and direct that Industrial Agreement No. 5 of 1925, dated the 20th day of January, 1925, declared a Common Rule, as varied by Order No. 441 of 1926 dated the 20th day of October, 1926, and Order No. 386 of 1930, dated the 13th day of October, 1930, be and the same is hereby further varied as follows:—

By the insertion of the following additional clause:—

10 (A).—Temporary Provisions as to Hours, etc.

(1) Notwithstanding anything contained in the above-named Agreement the following special provisions shall apply for a period of six months commencing 12th March, 1931, and ending 11th September, 1931:—

(a) The employer is empowered to suspend the employment of the worker for any two days or lesser period of time in each week and may deduct from the weekly wages a sum proportionate to the time of such suspension. So far as possible, due consideration being given to the employer's system of management and the nature of his business, the suspension from work hereby authorised shall be so arranged as to be distributed evenly amongst the workers concerned in each department of the business;

- (b) Where it suits the convenience of the employer's business, any worker may be employed for the full number of hours per week as laid down in Clause (3) and then stood down for one week at a time;
- (c) When the services of a worker are not required owing to the operation of Subclauses (a) and (b) hereof, the employer shall give the worker one day's notice thereof;
- (d) When the provisions of Subclauses (a) and (b) hereof are availed of, holidays as prescribed in Clause (5) of the Agreement or pay in lieu shall be reduced pro rata;
- (e) The provisions as to overtime in Clause (4) of the Agreement shall not be affected hereby, nor shall the worker's rights under Clause (13) of the Agreement be annulled in the event of the worker being dismissed permanently from his employment. Where a worker is engaged as a casual worker the provisions of Clause (6), (casual hands) (i) and (ii) shall still apply.

2. The foregoing provisions may be continued from month to month after the said 11th September, 1931, by agreement between the parties, a memorandum of which signed by or on behalf of the parties shall be filed in the Court. In the event of the parties failing to agree the matter may be referred to the Court.

3. The term "worker" herein shall, where the context so permits, include junior workers.

4. Save as is herein expressly provided and for the term or terms herein expressed or provided for, the said Industrial Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
