PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, TO WIT.

By His Excellency John Alfred Northmore, Administrator in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by "The State Savings Bank Transfer Act, 1931," it is provided that the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation, which day, however, shall not be later than one month after the said Act has been assented to: And whereas the said Act was assented to on the 16th day of October, 1931: Now, therefore I, the said Administrator,

do hereby, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, proclaim that "The State Savings Bank Transfer Act, 1931," shall come into operation on the first day of November, 1931.
