WHEREAS by "The Factories and Shops Act, 1920," it is enacted that the Governor may by Proclamation temporarily suspend the operations of the said Act, in so far as it applies to the closing time fixed or appointed for any shop or shops: And whereas it is expedient to exercise such power in manner hereinafter appearing: Now, therefore I the said Administrator, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby by this Proclmation suspend the operations of the said Act between the hours of eight o'clock and eleven o'clock in the morning of the 26th December, 1931, in so far as it applies to the closing time of Hair-dressers' shops situate within a radius of 15 miles from the General Post Office, Perth.

other railway shall be a District Railway; and whereas it is desirable that the undermentioned section of railway should be declared a District Railway: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Administrator of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Exceutive Council, does hereby declare that the railway from Meckatharra to Paroo, having a length of 66 miles 77 chains or thereabouts, shall be a District Railway.

### FARMERS' DEBTS ADJUSTMENT ACT, 1930.

NOTICE is hereby given that the following Stay Orders have been issued in accordance with Section 7, Subsection 1, of "The Farmers' Debts Adjustment Act, 1930," and Amendment Act, 1931, which reads as follows:—

A Stay Order shall direct that no action, execution, distress for rent, proceedings on default or breach of covenant under any mortgage or other security for money, or under an agreement of sale and purchase of land or other process or proceeding, shall be commenced or proceeded with or put in force against the farmer or his estate or effects during the operation of such Stay Order.
