Regulations concerning Constitution of Members of Courts of Native Affairs.

HIS Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor in Council has approved of the following Regulations for the purpose of Section 63 of "The Native Administration Act, 1905-1936":—

1. The Form of Commission constituting the members of a Court of Native Affairs under paragraph (a) of Subsection 2 of Section 63 of the Act shall be in accordance with the form in the First Schedule hereto, or as near thereto as the circumstances of the case may require.

2. The Form of Nomination of the Commissioner under paragraph (b) of Subsection 2 of Section 63 of the Act shall be in accordance with the form in the Second Schedule, or as near thereto as the circumstances may require.

THE NATIVE ADMINISTRATION ACT, 1905-1936.
Regulations Governing Procedure in Courts of Native Affairs.

Chief Secretary's Department,

HIS Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor in Council has approved of the following Regulations being made for the purpose of Section 63 of "The Native Administration Act, 1905-1936," dealing with the procedure in Courts of Native Affairs:—

1. Every trial of a native conducted by a Court of Native Affairs shall be held in the presence of the native.
2. Any Court constituted by the Governor under the Act may sit at any time and from time to time at any place or places within the District for which the Court is appointed, as may appear to the Court to be necessary.
3. Subject to preceding Regulations, the procedure at the trial shall be as nearly as practicable the same as that adopted in proceedings before justices on a trial of an offender for a simple offence.
4. The Court shall have all the powers and authorities of justices sitting in petty sessions to compel the attendance of witnesses, to administer oaths, and to issue process for the enforcement of its decision and judgments.
5. In the case of a division of opinion between the Special Magistrate appointed by the Governor's Commission and the Commissioner of Native Affairs, or the Protector nominated by the Commissioner under the Act, then the opinion of the Special Magistrate shall prevail.
6. The result of every trial and the sentence imposed, if any, on the accused native, shall be transmitted in writing by the Court to the Governor, and in transmitting such report the Court shall state whether it has had the assistance of the head man of the tribe to which the accused native belongs, the name of such head man, and, if the Court thinks necessary, make a general commentary on the circumstances of the case.

THE WESTERN AUSTRALIAN TURF CLUB.

ON 16th of February, 1937, the following alteration and additions to the Club's By-laws were sent to the Chief Secretary and have not been disallowed, namely:—

Alteration to By-law: By-law 21:—By deleting the words "forty-two" in line four and inserting in lieu thereof the words "twenty-one."

New By-law:

25A. Should any duly qualified candidate for election to the Committee die during the period commencing on the date of closing the nominations and ending on the day of the annual general meeting at the hour at which the annual general meeting is called or become ineligible for election within the same period, then and in any such case—

- (a) any ballot then pending for such election shall not be proceeded with and shall be of no effect;
- (b) the Committee shall as soon as practicable extend the respective times fixed by the By-laws for closing the nominations and for the commencement and closing of the ballot, but so that the ballot shall remain open for at least twenty-one days, and in such case the business of electing members of the Committee shall not be proceeded with at the ordinary general meeting, but the Committee shall convene a special general meeting for the day fixed by them for the closing of the ballot, at which meeting the result of the ballot shall be declared;
- (c) the Chairman shall cause an advertisement to be inserted in a Perth daily newspaper notifying the extended dates for closing the nominations and for the commencement and closing of the ballot and of the date of the special general meeting. A period of at least ten days shall be allowed between the first publication of such advertisement and the date for closing the nominations;
- (d) the provisions of By-laws 21, 22, 23, 24, and 25 shall apply to a ballot under this By-law, but references therein to the general meeting shall be construed as referring to the special general meeting to be convened under this By-law;
- (e) pending any such postponed election, the members of the Committee for the time being may act, notwithstanding the vacancy in their body and a majority of the members of the Committee for the time being present at any meeting of the Committee shall have all the powers by these By-laws given to the Committee.

THE HEALTH ACT, 1911-35,

Meat Inspection and Branding—Regulations.

P.H.D. 1377/19; Ex. Co. No. 479.

WHEREAS by the provisions of "The Health Act, 1911-35," His Excellency the Governor may make Regulations, and may repeal, alter, or amend Regulations so made: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and on the advice of the Advisory Committee, doth hereby amend the Regulations published in the *Government Gazette* on the 1st day of November, 1935, and the 14th day of February, 1936, as follows:—

Schedule "C" is hereby amended by the addition of a proviso to paragraph 4, as follows:—

Provided that, when any person or firm slaughters 150 or more head in any week, the fee payable per head shall be reduced to 4d.

This amended Regulation shall come into operation on the 14th February, 1936.
