THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS ACT, 1906.

By-law of the City of Fremantle.

P.W. 1331/34.

- Made under and by virtue of the powers conferred by "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1906," and Numbered 152, for Preserving or Promoting the Convenience of the Public in connection with Bathing:
- THE Mayor and Councillors of the City of Fremantle order and direct as follows:---

1. No person shall create or commit any nuisance or behave in a disorderly manner, or use indecent or improper language on the reserves, or upon the beach or any jetty.

2. No person shall climb on or over any building, shelter shed, or lavatory, or climb on or over any fence or fixture on the reserve or the beach, or upon or over any shelter shed erected on any jetty.

3. No person shall pry into or over or enter any lavatory, bathing shed, or building, or portion of a building erected upon the reserves or the beach expressly reserved for the use of the opposite sex.

4. No person shall enter any portion of the reserves or the beach which has been fenced off or otherwise closed to the public.

5. No person shall elimb, break, or injure any tree, or pull up or destroy any shrub or grass growing on the reserves or the beach.

6. No person shall, without the written permission of the local Authority, light any fires on the reserves or the beach, except in those places which may be specially set apart for the purpose.

7. No person shall cut, mutilate, deface or disfigure any jetty or any buildings, erections, fixtures or structures upon the reserves or the beach, or, without the written consent of the Local Authority, post, stick, stamp, stencil, paint, or otherwise affix, distribute, or give out any placard, handbill, notice, advertisement or any document whatsoever upon any tree, fence, post, gate, building, road, path, or any place whatever on the reserves or the beach, and no person shall cause to be done any of the acts herein prohibited.

8. No person shall expectorate or throw lighted matches upon any portion of any jetty, or upon any building, erection, or structure on the reserves or the beach.

9. No person shall place or break, or permit to be placed or broken, any glass, metal, bottle or utensils on the reserves or the beach, or water adjacent thereto, and no person shall deposit or leave any rubbish, refuse, paper, broken glass, china, or litter of any kind thereon, except in receptacles provided for that purpose.

10. No person shall, without the written consent of the Local Authority, remove any sand, soil, stone, timber, firewood, or other material from the reserves or the beach.

11. No person shall, without the permission of the Local Authority, allow any horse, cattle, sheep, donkey, mule, pig, or other animal, except a dog as provided by Clause 12, or any fowl or other bird, to enter or stray upon the reserves or the beach.

12. No person shall cause or permit any dog of which he is the owner, as defined by Section 4 of "The Dog Act, 1903-1928," or of which for the time being he has control, to be on that portion of the reserves or the beach as may be decided upon by the Local Authority from time to time. Any dog found on the reserves or the beach in contravention of this By-law may be destroyed.

13. No person shall, either on the reserves or the beach or upon any jetty without the written consent of the Local Authority—

- (a) in any way damage, alter, or interfere with the electric light fittings or electrical equipment;
- (b) sell or offer or expose for sale any goods or merchandise;
- (c) engage in public worship, preaching, or public speaking of any kind, or in any musical, dramatic, or athletic performance, or in any game dangerous or inconvenient to the public;

- (d) deface, alter, or remove from its position any notice board or other sign erected by the Local Authority;
- (e) take any intoxicating liquor into any bathing pavilion, dressing shed, or other building;
- (f) carry or discharge any firearm, or throw or discharge any stone or other missile;
- (g) moor any boat to the fence surrounding a protected bathing area.

14. Every person over the age of four years when bathing in the water or while on the beach or reserves shall be clad in a bathing costume covering the body at least to the extent provided in the following subclauses:—

- (a) the costume shall have legs at least three inches long;
- (b) the costume shall completely cover the chest and front of the body from a line at the level of the armpits down to the waist, joining with a piece covering the whole of the trunk, front, back and sides, and the covering shall descend without a break to the lower end of the leg covering, and the costume shall be provided with shoulder straps or other means of keeping it in position;
- (c) in the case of a person over the age of 12 years, the costume shall in addition have a half skirt attached to the waist, covering the front of the body below the waistline and descending to the lower end of the leg covering.

Provided that any person, when so directed by a Beach Inspector or Beach Officer, shall resume his ordinary attire.

15. No person shall use any surfboard on any portion of the beach other than that set aside for the purpose by the Local Authority, provided that no surfboard over $\frac{1}{2}$ inch in thickness shall be allowed within 50 yards north and south of the area set aside from day to day for bathing and surfing.

16. No person, without the written consent of the Local Authority, shall camp or lodge at night in or occupy as sleeping quarters any stall, building, or structure of any kind erected on the reserves or the beach, or erect any tent, camp, hut or structure of any kind on the reserves or the beach.

17. No person shall-

- (a) enter upon or remain on any jetty in bathing costume, without the permission of the Local Authority;
- (b) fish from any jetty, except from such portions as may by notice placed thereon be set aside by the Local Authority for that purpose;
- (c) fish from any portion of any jetty on any day when a notice is affixed thereon by order of the Local Authority prohibiting fishing therefrom;
- (d) clean fish or cut bait on the rails or seats, or deposit fish refuse on any portion of any jetty;
- (e) throw refuse, fish, offal, rubbish or any other object from any jetty;
- (f) bring any bicycle or other vehicle upon any jetty or upon any promenades or ramps;
- (g) engage in net fishing or lay bait or scatter burley in any portion of the area set aside from day to day by the Local Authority for bathing or surfing.

18. The Local Authority may at any time, and from time to time, charge a fee of not more than 6d. per head for admission to any jetty. At such times as such fee is payable, notice thereof shall be exhibited at the shore end of the jetty, and no person shall enter thereon unless in possession of a ticket, which must be produced on demand by any member or official of the Local Authority, or by any person authorised by the Local Authority.

19. The Local Authority may from time to time, or as occasion requires, enclose any portion of the beach or reserves during the holding of any entertainment thereon, and make such charges thereto as may to them appear fit.

20. No person shall when bathing in the sea on the boundary of the Local Authority:

- (a) create or commit any nuisance, or behave in a disorderly manner, or use indecent or improper language;
- (b) bathe or swim on any portion thereof which by notice erected in proximity thereto has been declared dangerous, or bathe at any place after being warned by an Inspector or lifesaving attendant that such place is danger-ous, or, if such place be indicated as dan-gerous by a "Danger" signal or notice;
- (c) swim out to see to such a distance as would endanger the lives of any member of the public or surf life-saver if attempting to rescue such person from danger or difficulty.

21. No person bathing in any open public water shall molest or in any way interfere with any other person bathing, or approach any bather in such a manner as may reasonably cause annoyance to such bather.

22. No person shall dress or undress on either the reserves or the bench, or in any building thereon, save only in those buildings specifically set apart for that purpose by the Local Authority.

23. No person shall bring into or consume on the reserves, jetties, or beach any intoxicating liquor, nor enter thereon when visibly under the influence of liquor.

24.No person shall remove, damage, deface, or otherwise interfere with any life-saving apparatus, signal bells, telephones or similar appliances, and no person other than an official of a recognised Surf Life-saving Club shall utilise same, except for the express purpose of saving human life.

25. The Local Authority may authorise any Volunteer Life-Saving Club-

- (a) to provide and use life-saving appliances and boats:
- (b) to use any such appliances and boats provided by the Local Authority; and
- (c) to erect, and, as may from time to time be necessary, remove from place to place danger signals or notices.

26. Where life-saving appliances are in use any Inspector may direct any person to cease assisting, or to stand back from the field of operations.

(a) The Local Authority may appoint any of its servants an Inspector under this By-law.

(b) The Local Authority may appoint any member of (b) The Local Authority may appoint any member of a volunteer Life saving Club an Inspector under this By-law: provided that a member so appointed shall not prosecute any person for a breach of any provision of this By-law, but shall report such breach to the Local Authority for action by it.

(c) Every constable or officer of Police shall have the powers of an Inspector under this By-law.

(d) Every Inspector may demand the name and address of any person guilty of a breach of any of the provisions of this By-law, and such person shall comply with such demand.

No person shall obstruct or hinder any Inspector or life-saving attendant in the performance of his duties. or in the exercise of his powers.

(f) The Local Authority shall supply each Inspector Authority, and with an appropriate badge. Every In-spector, when on duty, shall wear such badge on the front of his dress or bathing costume, or, if not wearing the badge, shall produce his written appointment, if de-manded of him when exercising authority under this Bylaw. The production of such badge or writing shall be prima facie evidence of the appointment of the person producing same.

28 (a) The lessee or person appointed by the Local Authority shall have charge of any dressing enclosure and shall be responsible for the maintenance of good order and conduct therein. Provided nevertheless that any Inspector or person appointed by the Local Authority shall have free access thereto at all times.

(b) The lessee or person appointed by the Local Authority, or any Inspector, may exclude from bathing at any public bathing place any child of tender years who is not accompanied by and in charge of an older person who is apparently capable of caring for such child.

29 A person suffering or appearing to the lessee, collector, Inspector, or person in charge to be suffering from any infectious, contagious, or offensive disease or skin complaint shall not visit or use any dressing enclosme.

30. (a) The Local Authority may charge for the use of dressing accommodation and requisites, or for the safe custody of valuables, such fees as shall from time to time be fixed by resolution of the Local Authority. Provided nevertheless that children attending public schools in the area, may, if in charge of a teacher who is a capable swimmer and an adept at life-saving, be admitted free of charge at such time and on such days as the Local Authority may appoint.

(b) Before entering or attempting to enter the Local Authority's bathing or dressing accommodation (in cases where fees for the use of such accommodation have been fixed), every person so entering or attempting to enter shall pay the fees fixed by the Local Authority.

31. (a) Persons dressed in bathing costume who have paid the prescribed fees, and whose ordinary clothes are within the Local Authority's bathing or dressing accommodution shall enter such accommodation by an entrance markel as "Entrance for persons in bathing costume," or marked to the like effect.

(b) Persons wearing their ordinary clothes, persons whose ordinary clothes are not within the Local Authority's bathing or dressing accommodation, and persons who have not paid the prescribed entrance fees, shall not enter such accommodation except by way of an not enter such accommodation except by way of an entrance marked as "Main Entrance," or marked to the like effect.

32. Any person attempting to do any of the things expressly or impliedly forbidden in this By-law shall be liable to a punishment as if he had committed the offence.

33. Every person offending against any provision of this By-law shall be liable for every such offence to a penalty not exceeding £10.
