PROCLAMATION.

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, } By His Excellency Major-General Sir Douglas

PURSUANT to section 6 of the Bank Holidays Act, 1970, I the said Governor with the advice and consent of the Executive Council do hereby Proclaim and Declare that it is in-expedient that the day appointed by the Bank Holidays Act, 1970, as a Bank Holiday (that is to say the 21st day of April, 1971), for the observance of the Birthday of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, which falls on the 21st day of April, 1971 should be observed on such firstmentioned date, and appoint the 11th day of October, 1971, as a Bank Holiday instead of such firstmentioned day.

AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, this 12th day of May, 1971, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:—

Fire Brigades Act, 1942-1966.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is enacted, *inter alia*, by subsection (2) of section 5 of the Fire Brigades Act, 1942-1966, that for the purposes of the Act the

Governor may from time to time, by Order in Council, constitute as a fire district any portion of a district of a local authority which after the coming into operation of the Fire Brigades Act Amendment Act, 1959, is not a fire district, assign a name to a fire district and include the name of a fire district in Part IV of the Second Schedule to the Act: now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council doth hereby—

- (a) constitute that portion of the municipal district of the Shire of Ashburton, more particularly described in the Schedule hereunder, a fire district;
- (b) assign the name Onslow Fire District to that district; and
- (c) include in column one of Part IV of the Second Schedule to the Act, "Onslow Fire District" and in column two opposite that name, the name of the local authority, "Shire of Ashburton".

Schedule.

Onslow Fire District.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting at a point on the High Water Mark of the Indian Ocean situate in prolongation north-westerly of the northeastern boundary of Ashburton Location 36, and extending generally north-easterly and generally southeasterly along that high water mark and generally southerly along the left bank of Beadon Creek to a point situate in prolongation south-easterly of the northeastern boundary of Location 36 aforesaid; thence north-westerly to and along that boundary and onwards to the starting point. (Public Plan Onslow Town-site (Sheet 2).)

Fire Brigades Act, 1942-1966.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (1) of section 5 of the Fire Brigades Act, 1942-1966, that, subject to the provisions of that section, the municipal districts and parts thereof constituted as fire districts prior to the coming into operation of the Fire Brigades Act Amendment Act, 1959, as set out in the Second Schedule to the Fire Brigades Act, 1942-1966, are for the purposes of that Act fire districts under the respective names as set out in that Schedule; and whereas a part of the municipal district of the Shire of Merredin is such a fire district with the name Merredin Fire District; and whereas it is further enacted, *inter alia*, by subsection (2) of that section that for the purposes of the Act the Governor may from time to time, by Order in Council, adjust the boundaries of a fire district: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby adjust the boundaries of the Merredin Fire District so that the boundaries of that fire district are as set out in the Schedule to this Order in Council.

Description of Boundaries of
Merredin Fire District.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting at the eastern corner of Avon Location 20686 and extending northeasterly to and along the southern boundaries of Locations 20685, 18030, 21479, 15605, 22021, 22022, 12577 and onwards along the southern boundary of Location 12576 and onwards to a point situate in prolongation northerly of the western side of Telfer Avenue; thence southerly to and along that side to a point situate in prolongation westerly of the southern boundary of Merredin Lot 811; thence easterly to and along that boundary and easterly along the southern boundaries of Lot 1170, Reserve 2914, Lot 810 and Reserve 20811 to the northwestern corner of Location 24301; thence southerly along that boundary and onwards to the northern boundary of Location 7785; thence northwesterly and southerly along boundaries of that location to a point situate in prolongation easterly of the southern boundary of Location 7757; thence westerly to and along that boundary to the western boundary of Location 27545; thence northerly and westerly along boundaries of that location and generally westerly along the southern side of a Pipe Line Reserve to the northeastern boundary of Reserve 8228; thence northwesterly along that boundary and onwards to the southern boundary of Location 3703; thence southwesterly along that boundary and the southern boundaries of Location 3535, Reserve 7940, Location 10366 and onwards to the eastern corner of Nangeenan Agriculture Area Lot 50; thence northwesterly along the northeastern boundary of that lot to its northeastern corner; thence northwesterly to the starting point.
