TRAFFIC ACT, 1919-1970.

Special Order Authorising Members of the Police Force to Perform Certain Duties as Inspectors. Police Commissioner's Office, Perth, 1st June, 1971.

UNDER subsection (4) of section 22 of the Traffic Act, 1919-1970, as approved for reprint on the 31st August, 1966 (tenth reprint), I, Athol Logan Moore Wedd, Commissioner of Police, hereby order that all members of the Police Force may, in all municipal and road districts outside or partly outside the Metropolitan Traffic Area as prescribed from time to time under the said Act and the regulations made thereunder, exercise and perform the duties of inspectors in relation to the making of all inquiries and investigations necessary to lay a complaint, the laying of complaints and the conduct of proceedings in respect of any offence against the said Act or regulations which may have been committed at the date of this order, or shall hereafter be committed.
