## PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency Rear-Admiral Sir Richard John To Wit: Jrowbridge, Knight Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Knight of Grace of the Most Victorian Order, Knight of St. John of Governor. LL.S.] Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS under the provisions of section 3 of the Constitution Act 1889-1980, it is lawful for the Governor to prorogue the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly, from time to time, and to dissolve the legislative Assembly by proclamation or otherwise whenever he shall think fit: Now, therefore, I, the Governor, in the exercise of the powers conferred by the Act, do hereby declare and proclaim that the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly shall stand prorogued as from the sixth day of January, Nineteen hundred and eighty-three, and that the Legislative Assembly shall be dissolved as from that date.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, this sixth day of January, Nineteen hundred and eighty-three.
