WHEREAS by clause XIV of the Letters Patent passed under the Great Seal of the United Kingdom constituting the office of Governor of the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, dated 29 October 1900, it is provided that in the event of the Governor having occasion to be temporarily absent from the seat of Government or from the State, he may in every such case, by an instrument under the Public Seal of the State constitute and appoint the Lieutenant-Governor, or if there be no such officer, or if such officer be absent or unable to act, then any other person, to be his deputy during such absence, and in that capacity to exercise, perform, and execute for and on behalf of the Governor during such absence, but no longer, all such powers and authorities vested in the Governor by such Letters Patent, as shall in and by such instrument be specified; and whereas I, the said Governor, propose to absent myself temporarily from the seat of Government: Now, therefore, I, the said Governor, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in me as aforesaid, do by this instrument under the Public Seal of the State constitute and appoint you the said Sir Francis Theodore Page Burt as from the time and date of my departure upon the said absence and during such absence to be my deputy, and in that capacity to exercise, perform, and execute for and on my behalf, as such Governor, all the powers and authorities vested in me by the said Letters Patent.

WHEREAS by the Transfer of Land Act 1893, the Governor is empowered by Proclamation in the *Government Gazette* to revest in Her Majesty as of Her former estate all or any lands, whereof Her Majesty may become the registered proprietor and whereas Her Majesty is now the registered proprietor of the lands described in the Schedule hereto:

## DOG ACT 1976-1977.

The Municipality of the Shire of Wagin.

By-laws Relating to Dogs.

IN pursuance of the power conferred upon it by the abovementioned Act and of all other powers enabling it, the Council of the abovementioned Municipality hereby records having resolved on 21 December 1982 to make and submit for confirmation by the Governor the following By-laws relating to dogs:—

## PART I—Preliminary.

1. In these By-laws unless the context otherwise requires—

“Act” means the Dog Act 1976-1977.

“By-law” means one of these By-laws.

“Clerk” means the Shire Clerk for the time being of the Shire of Wagin or the person acting for the time being in that capacity.

“Council” means the Council of the Municipality of the Shire of Wagin.

“Schedule” means a schedule to these By-laws.

“Sub-by-law” means a sub-by-law in which the term is used.

Expressions used in these By-laws have the meanings given to them by the Act.

2. These By-laws apply throughout the whole of the townsite of the Shire of Wagin.

## PART II—Impounding of Dogs.

3. The location of the pound to be used by the Shire of Wagin shall be advertised in the *Government Gazette* and a newspaper circulating in the district.

4. If the owner or person apparently acting on behalf of the owner of a dog seized or impounded shall claim such a dog, then upon payment of the fees specified in the first schedule hereto, the dog shall be released to such person, providing satisfactory evidence of ownership or authority to take delivery of the dog is produced.

5. If the Council shall destroy a dog at the request of its owner, whether such dog shall have been seized or impounded or not, the owner shall pay to the Council the fee specified in the first schedule hereto.

## PART III—Keeping of Dogs.

6. The occupier of premises shall not, unless the premises are licensed as an approved kennel establishment or have been granted exemption pursuant to section 26 (3) of the Act, keep or permit to be kept on those premises, more than two dogs over the age of three months and the young of those dogs under that age.

7. The occupier of the premises on which a dog is kept shall—

- (a) cause the premises or portion thereof on which the dog is kept to be fenced in a manner capable of confining the dog;
- (b) maintain the fence and all gates and doors in good order and condition.

8. (1) An application for a licence to keep an approved kennel establishment shall be in writing and shall be in or substantially in the form contained in the Second Schedule and shall be supported by evidence that due notice of the proposed use of the land has been given to persons in the locality.

(2) Unless the Council otherwise decides an application for a licence shall give notice of the proposed use of the land by:—

- (a) not less than one advertisement in a newspaper circulating in the district and
- (b) giving written notice to the owners and occupiers of all adjoining properties, at least thirty days before the application is made to the Council.

9. The fees payable for the issue or renewal of a licence to keep an approved kennel establishment is that specified in the First Schedule.

10. A person shall not erect a kennel unless it complies with the provisions of these By-laws and until plans and specifications and a location plan showing the proposed site for the kennel and of the yard appurtenant thereto have been approved by the Council and the fee for a licence prescribed in the First Schedule has been paid.

11. The owner or occupier of premises for which an approved kennel establishment licence has been granted shall provide and maintain kennels and yards in accordance with the following specifications:—

- (a) each kennel shall have a yard appurtenant thereto;
- (b) each kennel and each yard and every part thereof shall not be at any less distance than 10 metres from the boundaries of the land in the occupation of the occupier;
- (c) each kennel and each yard and every part thereof shall not be at any less distance than 24 metres from any road or street provided, however, that in the case of a corner, each kennel and each yard or part thereof shall not be at any less distance than 24 metres from the front boundary of the allotment and shall not be any less distance than 10 metres from the side boundary of the allotment;
- (d) each kennel and each yard and every part thereof shall not be at any less distance than 18 metres from any dwelling house, church, schoolroom, or factory;
- (e) the walls shall be rigid, impervious and structurally sound;
- (f) the roof shall be constructed of impervious material or that approved by the Council;
- (g) all untreated external surfaces of material shall be painted and kept painted with good quality paint;
- (h) the lowest internal height shall be at least 1.8 metres from the floor but the height can be reduced to 1.2 metres for a single kennel of floor area of not more than 2.0 square metres;
- (i) each yard shall be securely fenced and kept securely fenced with a fence not less than 2 metres in height constructed of galvanised iron, wood, galvanised link mesh or netting;
- (j) all gates shall be provided with proper catches or means of fastening;
- (k) the upper surface of the floor of each kennel shall be set at least 100 mm above the surface of the surrounding ground and shall be constructed of granolithic cement finished to a smooth surface, and shall have a fall of not less than 1 in 100; the entire yard shall be surrounded by a drain which shall be properly laid, ventilated and trapped; all floor washings shall pass through this drain and shall be disposed of in accordance with the health requirements of Council;



- (l) the floor of a yard shall be constructed in the same manner as the floor of a kennel;
  - (m) for each dog kept therein, every kennel shall have not less than 2 m<sup>2</sup> of floor space and every yard not less than 2.5 m<sup>2</sup>.
12. A person who keeps or permits dogs to be kept in an approved kennel establishment shall:—
- (a) keep dogs in kennels and yards appropriate to the breed or kind in question, site and maintained in accordance with the requirements of public health and sufficiently secured;
  - (b) not permit any dog to escape from the kennel or yard in which it is kept;
  - (c) maintain all kennels and yards and all feeding and drinking vessels used by dogs therein in a clean condition and cleanse and disinfect them when required so to do by an authorised person.
13. A right of appeal to a local court is conferred by section 27 of the Act where the Council refuses the grant of a licence or gives notice of intention to cancel a licence in respect of an approved kennel establishment.
14. Council shall not permit the establishment or maintenance of a kennel in any area if in the opinion of the Council such kennel would adversely affect the environment, be a nuisance to other residents or in any way otherwise be detrimental or prejudicial.

PART IV—General.

15. A person who fails to comply with or contravenes any of the provisions of these By-laws commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a maximum penalty of \$100.

## PREVENTION OF EXCESSIVE PRICES (DECLARATION OF GOODS AND SERVICES) NOTICE 1983.

MADE by the Minister for Consumer Affairs under section 10.

- Citation. 1. This notice may be cited as the Prevention of Excessive Prices (Declaration of Goods and Service) Notice 1983.
- Interpretation. 2. In this notice—  
 “dispensing equipment” has the meaning given in section 3 of the Petroleum Retailers Rights and Liabilities Act 1982;  
 “motor fuel” means petrol or diesel fuel intended for use in propelling motor vehicles;  
 “motor vehicles” has the meaning given in section 5 of the Road Traffic Act 1974;  
 “paragraph” means paragraph of this notice;  
 “the Act” means the Prevention of Excessive Prices Act 1983.
- Motor fuel declared goods. 3. Motor fuel supplied for use in the State is hereby declared pursuant to section 10 of the Act to be declared goods in relation to the whole of the State.

- Provision of certain accommodation a declared service.
4. (1) In subparagraph (2) of this paragraph—  
 “franchise agreement” has the meaning given in section 3 of the Petroleum Retail Marketing Franchise Act 1980 of the Commonwealth.
- (2) The provision for reward in accordance with a franchise agreement of any premises, being premises at which motor fuel—  
 (a) is sold by retail to persons within the State; and  
 (b) is usually dispensed through dispensing equipment,  
 is hereby declared pursuant to section 10 of the Act to be a declared service in relation to the whole of the State.
- Certain sellers of motor fuel to notify Commissioner of proposed increase in price.
5. Where a person specified in the Schedule to this notice, being a person who sells motor fuel in the State, proposes to increase the price at which the motor fuel is sold, he is hereby required, not less than 14 days prior to the day on which the proposed increase is to take effect, to notify the Commissioner in writing of the particulars of the proposed increase.
- Certain suppliers of declared service to notify Commissioner of proposed increase in rate.
6. Where a person who is a franchisor within the meaning of the Petroleum Retail Marketing Franchise Act 1980 of the Commonwealth, and is the supplier of a declared service of the kind referred to in paragraph 4, proposes to increase the price or rate payable for that declared service, he is hereby required, not less than 14 working days prior to the day on which the proposed increase is to take effect, to notify the Commissioner in writing of the particulars of the proposed increase.
- Combined sale of fuel and supply of accommodation.
7. Where a person is in relation to any premises both a seller of motor fuel and the supplier of a service to which paragraph 4 applies, and proposes to increase the price or rate applicable to that sale or supply, or to both the sale and the supply (whether or not by way of a combined figure), he is hereby required, not less than 14 working days prior to the day on which the proposed increase is to take effect, to notify the Commissioner in writing of the particulars of the increase.
- Rebates, etc.
8. For the purposes of the declaration to which this notice relates, a change or proposed change in the rebate or discount available in relation to a sale or service shall be taken to be a change applicable to the price or rate payable.
- Notice revoked.
9. The notice published under the Act in *Government Gazette* No. 23 of 1983 on 25 March 1983 relating to—  
 (a) motor fuel; and  
 (b) premises at which motor fuel is sold,  
 is hereby revoked.
