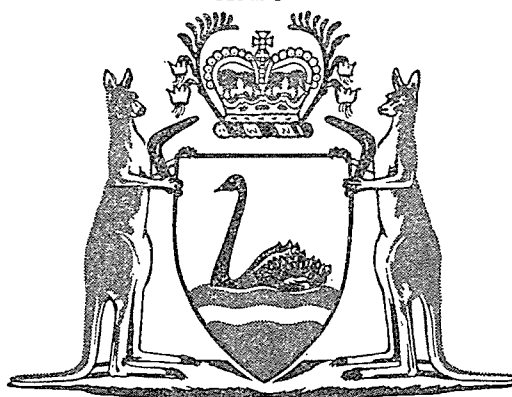

FISHERIES ACT 1905.

Notice No. 3.

F. & W. 147/75.

THE Minister for Fisheries and Wildlife pursuant to sections 9 and 11 of the Fisheries Act 1905 does hereby prohibit all persons from taking any species of prawns by any means of capture whatsoever in the waters specified in the first Schedule hereto at all times.

The notices relating to these waters published in the *Government Gazette* on 12 November 1982 and 21 January 1983 are hereby cancelled.

First Schedule.

All that portion of water bounded by lines starting from a point on the High Water Mark of the Indian Ocean situate south of the southernmost extremity of Locker Island, and extending north to the High Water Mark of that extremity; thence southwesterly to the High Water Mark of the northernmost extremity of Fly Island; thence southwesterly to the High Water Mark of the northernmost extremity of "Y" Island; thence west to the High Water Mark of Exmouth Gulf and thence generally southerly, generally easterly and generally northeasterly along the High Water Mark of the Indian Ocean to the starting point.
