RATES) ORDER 2006

Made under section 9.64 of the Act by the Governor in Executive Council.

**1. Citation**

This Order may be cited as the *Shire of Irwin (Validation of Imposition of Differential Rates) Order 2006*.

**2. Validation**

The imposition, by the Shire of Irwin of a differential general rate of—

- (a) 3.172 cents in the dollar of the unimproved value of rateable land in its district for properties described as a mining lease; and
- (b) 1.528 cents in the dollar of the unimproved value of rateable land in its district for properties described as other policy areas,

in accordance with section 6.33(1) of the *Local Government Act 1995* for the financial year ending 30 June 2005 are valid as if they had been imposed with the approval of the Minister as required by section 6.33(3) of the Act.

**PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT 2005**  
APPROVED LOCAL PLANNING SCHEME AMENDMENT  
*Shire of Greenough*  
Town Planning Scheme No. 4—Amendment No. 100

Ref: 853/3/7/6/Pt100

It is hereby notified for public information, in accordance with Section 87 of the *Planning and Development Act 2005* that the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure approved the Shire of Greenough local planning scheme amendment on 19 April 2006 for the purpose of—

- 1 Rezoning Victoria Location 1782 and Lot 150 from the 'General Farming' zone to the 'Public Utility' zone;
- 2 Inserting Section 4.6 into the Scheme Text as follows—
  - 4.6 OPERATION OF SPECIAL CONTROL AREAS
    - 4.6.1 The following Special Control Areas are to be shown on the Scheme Map—
      - (c) Narngulu Wastewater Treatment Plant Buffer Area shown on the Scheme Map as NWWTP.
    - 4.6.2 In respect of the Special Control Area shown on the Scheme Map, the provisions applying to the Special Control Area, apply in addition to the provisions applying to any other underlying zone or reserve or any general provisions of the Scheme.
    - 4.6.5 Narngulu Wastewater Treatment Plant Special Control Area.
      - 4.6.5.1 Purpose of the Special Control Area
        - (i) To identify land likely to be the subject of offsite impacts from the Narngulu Wastewater Treatment Plant.
        - (ii) To ensure that the use and development of the land in the vicinity of the Narngulu Wastewater Treatment Plant is compatible with any existing or proposed future use and development of the plant.
      - 4.6.5.2 Application Requirements

Planning approval is required to construct or extend a dwelling or other building, or to carry out any other form of development.

The Council will not generally approve any development for residential purposes or other sensitive uses as defined in Statement of Planning Policy 4.1.
      - 4.6.5.3 Relevant Considerations

Before deciding on any application for development approval the Council must consider—

        - (i) the provisions of the Statement of Planning Policy No.4.1: State Industrial Buffer Policy;
        - (ii) whether the proposal is compatible with existing and proposed future use of the Narngulu Wastewater Treatment Plant;
        - (iii) advice and recommendations of the Department of Environment, Department of Health and the relevant wastewater provider.
      - 4.6.5.4 Referral of Applications

Before deciding on any application for planning approval for residential purposes or any other sensitive use as defined in SPP 4.1 and with respect to land partly or wholly within the Special Control Area, the Council is to consult with the Department of Environment, Department of Health and the relevant wastewater provider.
- 3 Amending the Scheme Maps accordingly to—
  - (a) Designate Victoria Location 1782 and Lot 150 as being Public Utility;
  - (b) Introduce Special Control Areas to the Legend; and
  - (c) Introduce the Narngulu Wastewater Treatment Plant Special Control Area.
