Acting pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 67 of the *Western Australian Marine Act 1982*, I hereby cancel Notice MA401 as published in the *Government Gazette* on 20 April 2021 and hereby limit the speed of all motorised vessels to eight (8) knots within the following area;

THE FASCINE CARNARVON: All those waters of the Fascine and its entrance bounded in the north by a line across the waterway from 24°53.852′S, 113°38.532′E (at Pelican Point) to 24°54.053′S, 113°38.757′E (at Pickles Point); and bounded in the south by the western side of the Carnarvon Boat Harbour entrance channel (as defined by navigation markers) and a line from 24°54.641′S, 113°38.896′E (corresponding to nav marker 173); thence to 24°54.553′S, 113°38.514′E (corresponding to nav marker 172); thence to 24°54.493′S, 113°38.527′E (corresponding to nav marker 153); thence to the south-western end of the sandbar south of Pelican Point boat ramp. All coordinates based on GDA94.
