RETAIL TRADING HOURS (SHIRE OF COLLIE) CHRISTMAS AND PUBLIC HOLIDAY VARIATION ORDER 2022

Made by the Minister for Commerce under section 12E of the Act.

#### 1 Citation

This order is the Retail Trading Hours (Shire of Collie) Christmas and Public Holiday Variation Order 2022.

#### 2. Commencement

This order comes into operation as follows—

- (a) clauses 1 and 2—on the day on which this order is published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the order—on the day after that day.

#### 3. Variation of retail trading hours during Christmas 2022

(a) In this clause—

*Christmas 2022* means the period that begins on 17 December 2022 and ends on 24 December 2022 (both dates inclusive).
