WHEREAS by "The Tenants, Purchasers, and Mortgagors' Relief Act, 1930," it is provided that the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation: Now, therefore I, the said

Governor, do hereby, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, proclaim that "The Tenants, Purchasers, and Mortgagors" Relief Act, 1930," shall come into operation on the sixth day of January, 1931.
