TIMBER INDUSTRY REGULATION ACT, 1926-1950.

Forests Department, Perth, 9th March, 1955.

HIS Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor in Executive Council has been pleased, under the provisions of the Timber Industry Regulation Act, 1926-1950, and on the recommendation of the Controlling Officer appointed under the said Act, to amend the Timber Industry Regulations, 1927-1938, made under the said Act and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 2nd day of September, 1927, and amended from time to time thereafter, in the manner mentioned in the Schedule hereunder.

The abovementioned regulations are amended by deleting the table of fees from Regulation No. 85F, Part 7A, and inserting in lieu thereof a new Table of Fees as follows:—
