#### ELECTRICITY ACT, 1945-1953.

The State Electricity Commission of Western Australia, Perth, 21st July, 1955.

HIS Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor in Executive Council, under the provisions of the Electricity Act, 1945-1953, and on the recommendation of the State Electricity Commission of Western Australia has been pleased to amend in the manner mentioned in the Schedule hereunder, the Electricity Act Regulations, 1947, made under the Act and published in the Government Gazette on the 27th day of June, 1947, and amended by notices published in the Government Gazette on the 11th day of July, 1947, and the 25th day of March, 1948.

Schedule.

The abovementioned regulations are amended as follows:---

1. Regulation 3 is amended by deleting the definitions-

"Australian Standard Specifications."

"British Standard Specifications."

"Recognised Approvals Authorities."

2. Delete Part 10 (G.G. 11/7/47) and substitute a new Part 10 as follows:—

#### Part 10.

#### Approval of Electrical Appliances.

320. (1) Where an application has been made pursuant to the provisions of Part 10 of the Electricity Act Regulations, 1947, prior to the repeal of that Part by these regulations and the application has not been dealt with by the Commission or refused by the Commission, or withdrawn by the applicant, it shall be deemed to have been duly made under this Part and may be dealt with by the Commission under these regulations.

(2) Approval of any electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting under regulations repealed by these regulations shall not be cancelled or withdrawn by virtue of the repeal of those regulations.

(3) Any reference in these regulations to a certificate of approval issued by the Commission or held by any person shall extend to a certificate of approval issued under the regulations hereby repealed.
