PARKS AND RESERVES ACT, 1895-1955.

HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council, under the provisions of the Parks and Reserves Act, 1895-1955, has been pleased to approve of the amendments in the manner mentioned in the Schedule hereunder of the by-laws made by the Rottnest Board of Control and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 8th day of December, 1933, and amended by notices published in the *Government Gazette* on the 30th day of July, 1937, 1st day of April, 1938 and the 19th day of September, 1952.

Schedule.

Rottnest Island By-laws are amended by adding the following by-law after by-law 6.

6A. (a) In this by-law spear-gun has the same meaning as in the Spear-gun Control Act, 1955.

(b) No person shall bring a spear-gun onto Rottnest Island.

(c) After the publication of this by-law in the *Government Gazette*, no person shall carry a spear-gun on that Island, except for the purpose of removing the spear-gun from the Island.
