Principal regulations.

1. In these regulations the Companies Regulations, 1962, as reprinted pursuant to the Reprinting of Regulations Act, 1954, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 26th July, 1971 are referred to as the principal regulations.

Reg. 26 amended. 2. Subregulation (3) of regulation 26 of the principal regulations is amended by adding after the word "Perth" in paragraph (e) the word "Limited".

1. In these regulations the Firearms Regulations, 1931, reprinted pursuant to the Reprinting of Regulations Act, 1954, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 20th January, 1970, are referred to as the principal regulations.

Reg. 42 amended. 2. Regulation 42 of the principal regulations is amended by substituting for the words "for a pistol" in line one, the words "to possess a firearm".
