Citation.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Salaries and Wages Freeze (Western Australian Fire Brigades Board Operations Room Attendants Reference) Regulations 1983.

Interpretation.

2. In these regulations-

"the Act" means the Salaries and Wages Freeze Act 1982;

"the Commission" means The Western Australian Industrial Commission continued and constituted under the Industrial Arbitration Act 1979.

Reference of Meterence of matter to Western Australian Industrial Commission.

3. The matter of the appropriate weekly wage for each classification of operations room attendant to which the Fire Brigade Employees (Operations Room Attendants) Award No. 6 of 1959, as amended and consolidated, applies is hereby referred under section 12 of the Act to the Commission.

Minister.

The Commission is hereby requested under section 12 of the Act to recommend to the Minister, within a period of 42 days commencing on the day on which these regulations are published in the Gazette, what steps, if any, should be taken with respect to the matter referred to the Commission by regulation 3 of these regulations.
