SALARIES AND WAGES FREEZE ACT 1982.

SALARIES AND WAGES FREEZE (SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES REFERENCE) REGULATIONS 1983.

MADE by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council under section 12.

- Citation. 1. These regulations may be cited as the Salaries and Wages Freeze (Salaries and Allowances Reference) Regulations 1983.
- Interpretation. 2. In these regulations—
 “the Act” means the Salaries and Wages Freeze Act 1982;
 “the Tribunal” means the Salaries and Allowances Tribunal established by the Salaries and Allowances Act 1975.
- Reference of matter to Salaries and Allowances Tribunal. 3. The matter of the decision which—
 (a) was delivered on 23 September 1983 by a Full Bench of the Australian Conciliation and Arbitration Commission established by the Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1904 of the Commonwealth, as amended (in this regulation referred to as “the Commonwealth Act”);
 (b) relates to rates of wages and to various other matters; and
 (c) is applicable generally to awards made under the Commonwealth Act,
 is hereby referred under section 12 of the Act to the Tribunal.
- Salaries and Allowances Tribunal requested to make recommendations to Minister. 4. The Tribunal is hereby requested under section 12 of the Act to recommend to the Minister, within a period of 21 days commencing on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*, what steps, if any, should be taken with respect to the matter referred to the Tribunal by regulation 3 of these regulations.
