NOTICE is hereby given that, His Excellency the NOTICE is hereby given that, His Excellency the Governor having departed from the State, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor the Honourable Sir Francis Theodore Page Burt K.C.M.G. took the Oaths of Allegiance and Office before the Honourable Alkin Robert Alexander Wallace, Judge of the Supreme Court of Western Australia, and in the presence of members of the Executive Council and issued the following proclamation:-

TO all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING:

WHEREAS in certain Letters Patent under the Great Seal dated the 29th day of October, 1900, constituting the office of Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia it is provided that in the event of the departure of the Governor from the State the Lieutenant-Governor, if there be such an Officer in the State, shall during Her Majesty's pleasure, administer the Government of the State, first taking the Oaths in those Letters Patent directed to be taken by the Governor and in the manner therein prescribed; which being done the Lieutenant-Governor is by those Letters Patent authorized, empowered

and commanded by Her Majesty to do and execute, during Her Majesty's pleasure, all things that belong to the Office of the Governor according to the tenor of those Letters Patent and according to the instructions to the said Governor therein and the Laws of the State: and whereas Rear-Admiral Sir Richard John Trowbridge, Knight Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Knight of Green of the Most Venergella Order of the Horsitol of Grace of the Most Venerable Order of the Hospital of St. John of Jerusalem, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, has departed from the State: and whereas by a Commission dated the 19th day of April, 1977, I, Sir Francis Theodore Page Burt, was duly appointed Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia: now this is to give notice that In the said Sir Francis Theodore Page Burt, having duly taken the oaths required by the Letters Patent, have this day in pursuance of the Letters Patent, assumed the office of Administrator of the Government of the State; and that by the terms of the Letters Patent Her Majesty doth require and command all officers and Ministers, and all the other inhabitants of the State, to be obedient, within a part of the said Administration of the State, to be obedient, aiding and assisting unto me the said Administrator.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, this 25th day of November, nineteen hundred and eighty-three.
