1 Citation

This instrument is the Mackerel Fishery (Interim) Management Plan Amendment (No. 2) 2006.

2. Instruments amended

- (1) The amendments in clause 3 of this instrument are to the Mackerel Fishery (Interim) Management Plan 2004*.
- (2) The amendment in clause 4 of this instrument is to the Mackerel Fishery (Interim) Management Plan Amendment 2006**.

3. Clause 13 amended

- (1) Clause 13(2) is amended—
 - (a) by deleting "and" at the end of paragraph (c); and
 - (b) by deleting paragraph (d) and inserting instead—
 - "(d) the person who was the holder of the fishing boat licence referred to in paragraph (a) on 31 July 2006 did not apply for a permit to fish in Area 2 on or before 13 October 2006;" and
 - (e) the person applies for a permit on or before 22 December 2006. ".
- (2) Clause 13(3) is amended—
 - (a) by deleting "and" at the end of paragraph (c); and
 - (b) by deleting paragraph (d) and inserting instead—
 - "(d) the person who was the holder of the fishing boat licence referred to in paragraph (a) on 31 July 2006 did not apply for a permit to fish in Area 3 on or before 13 October 2006;" and
 - (e) the person applies for a permit on or before 22 December 2006. ".

4. Clause 2 deleted

Clause 2 is deleted.
